

SMALL GROUPS

We have about 118 people in small groups. These groups met this past year to study God's Word, pray with one another and serve together this past year.

MINISTRIES

EQUIP CLASSES

We saw much spiritual and numerical growth in our Wednesday night Equip classes. We went through topics like: what we believe as a church, how to counsel one another biblically, parenting, and church history. The women met to study what the Scripture has to say about loneliness and the men met to study what Scripture has to say about purity.



MEN'S MINISTRY

The Men's Bible study meets on Tuesday Mornings and grew together by studying Mark, Philippians and Matthew. We are so grateful for how this ministry helps to make us into faithful, Christlike men.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Crosspointe Women's Ministries strives to provide rich theology by creating an environment to grow deeper in the Word while cultivating lasting Christ-centered relationships. We did a 20 week series in Exodus emphasizing the main theme of redemption. Then Hebrews exhorted us to hold fast our confession to the end. Our 5th Annual Christmas Brunch was a great success filling the sanctuary as we celebrated "The Unexpected Gift" of Jesus.

STUDENT MINISTRY

Thanks for all the support the church gives our high school and middle school students through prayer and finances. Also for engaging students week in and week out as a part of the body of believers. Both groups are averaging about 12 students on Sunday nights but the middle school group has seen a lot of growth in recent months. Here are some highlights:

- The middle school students had their summer trip to Twelve Stones where they served by doing trail maintenance and other tasks.
- The high school students spent a week in Pawley's Island, SC where they led a VBS and did a service project at a local ministry called Teach My People.

YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY

This summer, we launched a new young adult group. This group has grown to have about 12 people attending each Monday night. The group meets to grow by praying for one another, studying and discussing God's Word together.

in 2022 Awana has blessed 75+ children from preschool through 5th grade with weekly Scripture memorization, rewards for their hard work, and a fun games time with their peers. It's also been a joy to have a few children from around our community attend who don't already attend a Bible-believing church and can have an opportunity to hear the Gospel of Jesus on a weekly, basis.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

This past year a second preschool class was added to accommodate the growing number of 2 and 3 year old children, and other age groups are growing as well. We are thankful to have welcomed several new families. We praise the Lord for all He has done and continues to do. All glory to Him!

MISSIONS

SPAIN

In July of 2022 we took a mission trip to Spain. The team members worked to help a camp called Pena De Horeb. The camp is in need of revitalization and this team of 17 was able to complete several major projects!



PAWLEY'S ISLAND

In June of 2022 a team of our students went to serve the community of Pawley's Island SC. The students served several local ministries and put on a VBS for local kids.

BACKYARD BIBLE CLUBS

This past summer, Crosspointe members hosted four Backyard Bible Clubs in various neighborhoods in the Greenwood area. Children heard the Gospel at these clubs! We praise the Lord for this opportunity to reach out to our neighbors, and trust Him to give the increase.



FINANCE

KINGDOM BUILDING

Crosspointe CC contributed \$67,048 to global and local missions outreach. Here are some highlights:

- We have contributed over \$10,000 to local organizations such as Life Centers, Family Hope and Indiana Family Institute.

MORTGAGE REDUCTION

Because of your generosity, we were able to retire over \$186,000 of our debt in 2022. This 19% reduction in the loan principal will save tens of thousands of dollars in interest payments.



OTHER HIGHLIGHTS

- Total contributions for all funds in 2022 were \$821,251 from over 120 individuals and families.
- A number of enhancements were made to our building in order to improve the effectiveness of ministries.
- We began working on a site master plan that considers our culture, ministries, use of space and how we might expand when the time is right.

WHAT ELSE HAPPENED THIS YEAR?

CAMP ATTERBURY

At the end of 2021 and beginning of 2022 Afgan refugees were brought to Camp Atterbury. A ministry was organized to go and spend time talking to and loving these people as they were displaced. Our church had the joy of taking part in serving and loving these people.



LAKE CHARLES

Louisiana was hit with 2 devastating hurricanes. In 2022, several people from our church went with Men For Missions to aid people with little or no insurance. This was a great opportunity to love and serve others.

FAMILY HOPE PARTNERSHIP

Our church has partnered with Family Hope. This ministry equips parents to provide and parent their children and provides housing and loving caretakers for children who need temporary housing.
