# ECUADOR

#### **GLOBAL OUTREACH**

The high school students went to Pallatanga, Ecuador, for their annual mission trip. They helped build a low ropes course for the Christian camp where they stayed. Our students also taught English at a local school. We are greatly encouraged to see the unity of our students and the work the Lord is doing in their lives.

### SPAIN

Crosspointe partnered with One Mission Society for the second consecutive year in 2023 to be part of a major initiative to renovate and repair camp Peña de Horeb in Auñon, Spain. Crosspointe sent 19 people from June 2-10. They painted multiple buildings and helped to complete other projects around the camp.



# KINGDOM BUILDING

Crosspointe contributed \$97,760 to global and local outreach. Here are some highlights:

- We have contributed \$8,360 to local organizations such as Life Centers, Family Hope, Twelve Stones and Midwest Food Bank.
- This year, our Christmas offering went to support Mercy, Inc. and the work they do rescuing children from trafficking. We were able to give them \$48,701 to purchase a van for transportation and provide counseling for the rescued children.

# **\$97,760** Given Away

- We continue to support our Crosspointe missionaries and other mission agencies on a monthly and as-needed basis.
- We contributed \$11,550 to FAMM and One Mission Society for global missions.

# MORTGAGE REDUCTION

Because of your generosity, we were able to retire \$103,560 of our debt in 2023. This 13% reduction in the loan principal will save tens of thousands of dollars in interest payments. Mortgage Reduced 13%
